## POT LIMIT OMAHA & NO LIMIT TEXAS HOLD'EM POKER TOURNAMENTS

### TOURNAMENT RULES:

- 1 - All players must have or obtain an Aces Rewards card to play in any Running Aces tournament.
- 2 - Sign up will be via text message or by calling the poker board at (651) 925-4569 and requesting to be added to the game. If you want to get the text notification regarding poker tournament information, please email info@runaces.com and provide your name and telephone number. \*standard message rates apply.
- 3 - Seats will be held until 10 minutes before the scheduled start. Seats will be held in order of sign up sequence. If you have not reported to the poker lead prior to 10 minutes before the scheduled start, your seat will be opened up to the next waiting player.
- 4 - TDA rules are in effect for this tournament. All Tournament Director decisions are final. The poker lead will be the tournament director for all timed games.
- 5 - Players will receive a starting stack equal to their buy-in on a dollar for dollar basis, less the event fees. Tournaments will be a minimum of three hours in length and will be agreed upon before the start of the tournament. Upon unanimous player agreement, tournament time may be extended once, for up to two hours. In the event of a tournament extension, Running Aces will collect entry fees from each player for each extended hour, before the tournament extension starts.
- 6 - Event Fees: \$15 per hour played, plus \$10 for every rebuy/add-on. Hourly fees are distributed as follows: \$11 entry fee; \$4 admin fee. Rebuy and add-on fees are distributed as follows: \$8 entry fee; \$2 admin fee. Admin fees are distributed to tournament staff and are not retained by Running Aces.
- 7 - Tournament will have two blind levels, with a 10 minute break in between blind level changes. The first blind level will run for approximately half of the scheduled tournament time, with the second blind level running for the remainder of the tournament. In the event a tournament is extended for time, a third blind level will be added.
- 8 - The following blind levels will be available for tournaments: Pot Limit Omaha - 5/5 and 5/10, or higher as agreed upon by players (must be established before the start of the tournament); No Limit Texas Hold'em - 1/3 and 2/5 for under \$1,000 buy-in's, 2/5 and 5/5 for buy-ins of \$1,000 or higher.
- 9 - Players will play the entire tournament, either until they run out of chips or the tournament time ends. If players have chips when the tournament time runs out, the players will cash their chips out on a dollar for dollar basis with the tournament director.
