## NEW FOR 2021 RACING SEASON!

## THE 20\$ PLACE PICK ALL

Starting in the first race of the night correctly select a horse to finish first or second in every race on the card ( 8,9 or 10) races. On 11 or 12 race cards it will be a PLACE PICK TEN (on the first ten races of the card). With only a 204 minimum you can use more than one horse in a race for more action.

EXAMPLE: RUNNING ACES RACE 1
$20 \not \subset$ PLACE PICK ALL (8 race card)
1-2/1-3/2-4/5-6/1-7/2-5/2-8/3 - BEST COST \$25.60

## THE . 50 CENT PENTAFECTA IS BACK

Running Aces proudly offers the "Hi-5" or Pentafecta wager again This wager was extremely popular last season and produced some very large pools with an average .50 cent payoff of over $\$ 900.00$
*The .50 cent Hi-5 will once again be offered in the last 2 races every night *This wager requires you to select the top 5 finishers in exact order in a single race
*Should there be no winners with the exact top 5 finish order, the entire pool will carry over to the next scheduled $\mathrm{Hi}-5$ race

## SAMPLE HI-5 WAGERS \& TICKET COSTS :

Example wagers and how to ask for your wager
"Running Aces Race 9 ... Hi-5 ... 5 with 4 with 1,2,6 with 1,2,6 with 1,2,6" $=$ Cost $\$ 3.00$
"Running Aces Race 10 ... Hi-5 ... 1 with 2 with 3 with 4,5 with 4,5,6,7" = Cost \$3.00

## BOXING YOUT BETS

Bets on every possible winning combination for \# of horses selected. Combines multiple straight bets. Horses can finish in any order.

EXAMPLE: Running Aces, Race 5, \$1 Exacta Box, 2-3 (Horses must finish 1st and 2 nd. Two bets totaling a $\$ 2$ wager)

EXAMPLE: Running Aces, Race 5, \$1 Exacta Box, 2-3-4 (Horses must finish 1st and 2 nd. Six bets totaling a $\$ 6$ wager)

EXAMPLE: Running Aces, Race 5, \$1
Trifecta Box, 2-3-4-5 (Horses must finish 1st, 2nd, \& 3rd. Twenty four bets totaling a $\$ 24$ wager)

## WHEELS \& KEYS

Select the exact order of finish but combines multiple straight wagers Commonly used when confident that a horse will win.

EXAMPLE: Running Aces, Race 6,
\$1 Exacta, 6 / 3-4-5
(6 must finish 1st, 3,4, or 5 2nd)
EXAMPLE: Running Aces, Race 6,
\$1 Trifecta, 6 / 3-4-5 / 3-4-5
( 6 must finish 1st, 3,4 , or $52 n d$, and 3,4 , or 5 3rd)

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Uncashed tickets - MN law requires that all outstanding tickets are removed from the totalizer system and reported to the state of MN 90 days after the close of Running Aces live season. ALL uncashed voucher and wagers that can be clearly identified will be honored at any time.

You can bet and cash tickets for any race at all windows. Simple wagers and most exotic wagers can be placed "up to the sound of the bell" -which denotes the post time of each race (You can bet several races at once).

Official order of finish and $\$ 2$ payoffs are posted on the tote board and the in-house television screens as soon as the race is made official.

The term "handle" refers to total amount of money bet and can be applied to the daily handle, weekly handle or annual handle

Pari-mutuel wagering means "Among Ourselves". You win or lose money from other players. You do not play the racetrack as the house. The track has no interest in which horses win. The track wants you to be a winner!

HOW TO PLACE A WAGER
Select the exact order of finish but combines multiple straight wagers. Commonly used when confident that a horse will win.
EXAMPLE: Running Aces, Race 6,\$1 Exacta, 6 / 3-4-5 (6 must finish 1st, 3,4, or 5 2nd)
EXAMPLE: Running Aces, Race 6,\$1 Trifecta, 6 / 3-4-5 / 3-4-5 (6 must finish 1st, 3,4, or 5 2nd,and 3,4, or 5 3rd)

## RUNNING ACES INTRODUCES THE NEW 20 CENT JACKPOT PICK 5 WAGER

- Pick the winner of 5 consecutive races to win
- Last 5 races every night
- Single unique winning ticket takes the entire pool for a "jackpot"
- Multiple winners share 50\% of the net pool, and 50\% is carried over in the "jackpot pool"
- Low take-out of only $20 \%$

Play multiple horses in each race to greatly increase your chances of winning
EXAMPLE: "Running Aces 20 cent pick 5 ... 1 with 2,3 with $4,5,6$ with 7,8 with $1,2^{\prime \prime}$
The cost for this example bet is $\$ 4.80$

Calculating pick bet ticket costs is fairly simple, just multiply the number of horses that you are playing in each leg (race) of the bet sequence, then multiply that number by the base bet amount ( 20 cents for the pick 5) from the example wager above, it's $1 \times 2 \times 3 \times 2 \times 2$ which equals 24 . Then $24 \times 20$ cents equals the ticket cost of $\$ 4.80$

Remember, multiple winners will be paid every night, and the jackpot pool will build until there is a single unique ticket. After each jackpot is won the jackpot pool will start over on the next racing night. Good luck. You could be the next big jackpot winner!
