MAIN EVENT RULES

- All players must have or obtain an Aces Rewards card to play in any Running Aces tournament.
- Tournament registration opens 2 hours prior to the start of the flight, with late registration available through the end of level 10. Unlimited re-entry's.
- Alternates may register and will be seated when seating is available. Tournament director reserves the right to make tables 10 handed as needed.
- TDA rules are in effect for this tournament. All Tournament Director decisions are final.
- Event buy-in: \$300: \$240 to prize pool; \$42 entry fee; \$18 admin fee. Admin fees are distributed to tournament staff and not retained by Running Aces.
- 25,000 starting chip stack. Blind levels are 20 minutes in length. 10 minute breaks occur every 2 hours of play during day 1 flights. Day 2 breaks occur every 2 hours of play. When the field is reduced to 9 players, the final table seats will be drawn, and a 30 minute dinner break will ensue.
- Day 1 flights will play down to 11% of the field, rounded up. Play will finish in hand for hand mode, if necessary. Players who finish day 1 with chips will be in the money on day 2. Day 2 will have all players restart with the original 25K starting stack and play will begin starting with level 1 of the blind structure.
- Players can play multiple day 1 flights if they so desire, including getting multiple milestones in the same flight. Players who make day 2 multiple times will receive a minimum cash for the non-playing entries they have.
- A Player who who accumulates 250,000 in tournament chips ("The Milestone") or more will have the option to immediately advance to day 2, or continue to play the event. Upon verification from the Tournament Supervisor that the player has achieved the Milestone, the player may cease play, the total of his/her chips will be removed from play and he/she will be awarded at that point. Players do have the option of continuing to play - milestone is not awarded until the player halts playing and is at or above the milestone mark at that point. In the event that players remain in a day 1 flight but all seats for that flight to day 2 have been awarded via milestone, the remaining players will have the opportunity to continue playing down to one player remaining, who will then advance to day 2.
- Table breaks will be completed in accordance with casino need, then random. There will be no posted break order.
- Big Blind Ante Format is in play. The Big Blind will post the ante as scheduled by level. The ante is dead money. All players have a right to win the ante. Antes do not reduce at any point. In the event the big blind does not have enough to cover both the big blind & the ante, big blind will be paid first, then then ante.

THE GREAT MN SATELLITE RULES

- Event buy-in: \$100: \$75 to prize pool; \$18 entry fee; \$7 admin fee. Admin fees are distributed to tournament staff and not retained by Running Aces.
- 15,000 starting chip stack. Blind levels are 15 minutes in length. 10 minute breaks occur after levels 8 and 14, then subject to tournament director discretion.
- Satellite Payouts will be as follows: \$350 in tournament lammers (may be used for any tournament offered at Running Aces) & \$25 cash. Any remaining prize pool will be awarded in lammers & cash to the player on the bubble. Lammers are transferable.
- A Player who accumulates 80,000 in tournament chips ("The Milestone") or more will have the option to instantly be awarded \$350 in tournament lammers and \$25 in cash, or continue to play the event. Upon verification from the Tournament Supervisor that the player has achieved the Milestone, the player may cease play, the total of his/her chips will be removed from play and he/she will be awarded at that point. Players do have the option of continuing to play - milestone is not awarded until the player halts playing and is at or above the milestone mark at that point.
